

CONSUMER'S CONSENT TO THE RESOLUTION OF A DISPUTE BY ARBI3

I have been informed that this dispute may be resolved either by a common court or by an arbitral tribunal (arbitration), and that the **"ARBI3 Arbitration Court"** operated by **Arbitrzy sp. z o.o.** (**hereinafter: "ARBI3"**) is an arbitral tribunal.

I have been informed and understand that:

1. if I give this consent to arbitration, the dispute will be heard by ARBI3 instead of by a common court;
2. if I do not give this consent, the case may still be heard by a common court;
3. an award issued by ARBI3, once recognised or declared enforceable by a common court, has the same force as a judgment of a common court.

Having read the above information, I voluntarily consent to the dispute described above being resolved by the "ARBI3 Arbitration Court" operated by Arbitrzy sp. z o.o. (KRS No. 0000922638), in accordance with the rules and statutes of that tribunal, available at www.arbi3.pl (links to downloadable files are available in the website footer). I also confirm that I have read the additional information on arbitration for consumers available at www.arbi3.pl/en/consumer.

I acknowledge that ARBI3 is a tribunal whose purpose is to ensure the prompt and professional resolution of disputes within 30 days. Accordingly, I declare and undertake that, for the duration of the proceedings before ARBI3:

1. I will promptly update my contact details provided in this consent;
2. I will review correspondence sent to me (by email and SMS) at least once every 5 working days and will promptly provide any information and evidence relevant to the resolution of the dispute.

I understand that failure to comply with the above rules may result in an award being issued against me, which, once recognised or declared enforceable by a common court, will be binding and enforceable.

I declare that I am giving this consent knowingly and voluntarily, and that, should I have any questions before giving this consent, I may contact ARBI3 by email at biuro@arbi3.pl.
